

Moderate includes Funds with VF that are above 8.74 but not more than 11.415. High includes Funds with VF that are above 11.415 but not more than 15.88. Very High includes Funds with VF that are above 15.88. The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return or downside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
