



Moderate includes Funds with VF that are above 9.205 but not more than 12.195. High includes Funds with VF that are above 12.195 but not more than 9.205. Note of the fund in generating an upside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guaranteed that the Fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future.
