



Based on the Fund's portfolio returns as at May 31 2024, the Volatility Factor (VF) for this Fund is 9.8 for MYR Class (Moderate) (source: Lipper). Very Low includes Funds with VF that are not more than 3.765. Low includes Funds with VF that are above 3.765 but not more than 8.515. Moderate includes Funds with VF that are above 8.515 but not more than 11.01. High includes Funds with VF that are above 11.01 but not more than 14.645. Very High includes Funds with VF that are above 14.465. The VF means there is a possibility for the Fund in generating an upside return around this VF. The Volatility Class (VC) is assigned by Lipper based on quintile ranks of VF for qualified funds. The Fund's portfolio may have changed since this date and there is no guaranteed that the Fund will continue to have the same VF or VC in the future. Presently, only funds launched in the market for at least 36 months will display the VF and its VC.
